STATEMENT ON THE OBSERVANCE OF FOUNDER'S DAY 2023

The Socialist Movement of Ghana (SMG) will observe this year's Founder's Day with a street carnival on Kotoko Avenue, in front of the Freedom Centre at Kokomlemle Accra, on Friday, September 22, 2023.

The event will feature reggae and highlife music by the Freedom Band, the exhibition of Nkrumah memorabilia, including books and t-shirts and the sale of African and Ghanaian food.

It is expected to start at 11 am and end at 12 midnight.

The SMG invites all mass and progressive organizations, including political parties, trade unions, youth and student movements, women's organisations and faith-based groups, to join in the celebration of Osagyefo Dr Kwame Nkrumah as the Founder of Ghana and an inspiration for the national liberation movement throughout Africa and the world.

On the 112th anniversary of his birth, the SMG rededicates itself to the full realisation of his dreams of the total liberation of the African continent from colonial exploitation in all its forms and the construction of a united Africa under the banner of scientific socialism.

To this end, we remain implacably opposed to the colonial occupation of the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic by Morocco and the struggle to free the Garcia Islands from Western occupation.

The SMG is vehemently opposed to all forms of colonialism and opposes the imposition of apartheid colonialism on Palestine, and demands the establishment of an independent Palestinian state with a secure border with Jerusalem as its capital.

We urge all our members throughout the country to fully participate in all manifestations organised by all other movements and organisations to celebrate Kwame Nkrumah on September 21, 2023.
